What is School Social Work and to whom does it apply?

School Social Work is an offer of counselling and support for pupils, parents, teachers and coworkers at school.

Pupils are going to receive immediate and uncomplicated help and support. In case of anxiety, worries, conflicts or questions about living together they can call upon school social work counselling whether alone or in groups. This involves looking closely at the situation and finding mutual solutions.

Parents are welcome to contact School Social Work if they have concerns over their child's development or over a situation at school. School Social Work can help to gain clarification, has got expertise in many questions about school and development and knows the other competent authorities.

Teachers can discuss complicated situations of an individual or a group together with School Social Work. In all cases, problems will be taken up and solved jointly.

School Social Work can initiate and accompany projects or activities for the whole **school** or in a **single class**.



How is School Social Work working?

School Social Work is **present** at school, has regular office opening hour or can be **reached** via telephone. Contacting us is easy.

An individual counselling is usually **voluntary**. The first counselling session can be initiated by the teacher.

The offer is **confidential**. The school social workers operate under professional secrecy.

The services are **free of charge**.

When can parents contact School Social Work?

In case they are worried about their child's development or they are concerned about a situation.

It's better to be early than late!

Better once too often, than once too few!

Not every time, school social work is called upon means a big crises has to be dealt with!
